REGISTRATION AND ON-SITE ATTENDANCE

As presenting author, your presence is requested onsite in Madrid. You are therefore kindly requested to register for the Congress ([here](#)). The early registration fee will be applied automatically.

IMPORTANT NOTE – Please read carefully

Should the presenter (or designated replacement presenter) not be registered* by **30 September 2026**, the abstract will be excluded from presentation in the ESMO 2026 programme and removed from the online programme and publication in the ESMO 2026 Abstract Book.

*Payment must be effective by 30 September 2026.

If you are paying by bank transfer, please allow sufficient time for processing.

If you are part of a group registration and are unsure whether the payment will be completed by 30 September, please contact groups@esmo.org in advance.

Should you not be able to attend in person for professional or personal reasons, a co-author (independent of the sponsor) must be nominated as new presenter and must register for the Congress. Please inform programme@esmo.org as soon as possible.

PREPARATION OF YOUR PAPER POSTER

- It is mandatory to print and hang your Poster on the related Poster board available in the **Poster Area, Hall 5 (EONS19 at the Palacio Municipal IFEMA)**.
- Paper posters must be in horizontal (landscape) format, with a size of **190 cm (width) × 110 cm (height)**.
- Please clearly add the Final Publication Number (FPN) to your paper poster. If you don't know your FPN, please check-in the poster list in the [online programme](#).
- An optimal lay-out of your poster will attract the attention of other Congress participants. Text should be easy to read at a 1-meter distance. Use colour wherever possible. You must include all material to support your presentation, such as tables, drawings, charts and pictures.
- It is strictly mandatory that the first and presenting author includes a [disclosure statement](#) on the Poster, even if only to confirm that if he/she has no conflicts of interest to declare. Co-author disclosures are not mandatory on the Poster.
- At the bottom of the poster, you can include your and/or the corresponding author email address. This will prove especially useful if another ESMO 2026 delegate wishes to contact you about your work.
- If the study has received funding, this must also be acknowledged on your poster: “Study sponsored by...”

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- QR (Quick Response), AR (Augmented Reality), text key codes are allowed. However, although ESMO accepts that these may go to a commercial/branded website, we suggest avoiding links to websites containing blatant product advertising. If you intend adding a QR, AR or a text key code to your poster, please add the following disclaimer notice: "Copies of this poster obtained through QR, AR and/or text key codes are for personal use only and may not be reproduced without written permission of the authors".
- Posters may not present a commercial bias or use clearly identifiable commercial templates. The ESMO 2026 reviewers will be responsible for advising the Scientific Committee of any inappropriate commercial bias, promotion or branding unless clearly stated in a balanced and objective manner.

E-POSTER UPLOAD

It is also mandatory to prepare an e-Poster, which will be available via searchable screens located onsite in **Hall 5**.

E-Posters can be uploaded in **PDF format** – maximum file size **500 MB**, horizontal (landscape) format, with a size of **190 cm (width) × 110 cm (height)**.

The deadline to upload the e-Poster to the online Congress portal is **21 October 2026, 21:00 CEST**.

Changes to an already uploaded e-Poster may be possible; however, please note that any version uploaded after the above mentioned deadline cannot be guaranteed of publication on the Congress virtual platform, on searchable screens onsite and on OncologyPRO post Congress.

Instructions for the ePoster upload to the online Congress portal will be sent to first authors by our technical supplier on 31 August 2026.

Please note that only the presenting author will have access to the online Congress portal.
